In the fall of 2018 we purchased a herd of Angus cows from Brent and Dale Stewart of Stewart Cattle Co. and for the last 5 years we have sold angus bulls in our yearly bull sale but never before have we sold a female with the JLN tattoo. We have grown the angus cow base to a number where we are comfortable with letting a few go. Being the first angus we have offered we knew we had to step out in a big way. After much discussion we have decided to offer choice on an exciting pair of heifer calves and a pair of breds, and are following up the choice lots with a couple of exceptional bred heifers.

Another new addition to the sale this year is couple of semen packs off the National Grand Champion Simmental Bull Wheatland Dimensional 1147J.

The heifers were preg-checked at the beginning of August, which allowed our vet to give us an accurate decision on being safe to AI date or bull. The heifers are all on a full vaccination program and will have received their first shot of Scour-Guard before the sale.


